# Moodle – Student User Manual

Welcome to OCTEC Learning!

We are very excited to have you undertake one of our courses to gain new skills or refresh your skills for the workforce. This manual is to assist you in the steps to logging into your course using Moodle, our platform that hosts our courses. The manual will show you where to find your course, course information, how to submit an assignment and where to find your assessment responses and grades.

#### Step 1. Accessing OCTEC Learning in Moodle

Click the Moodle link provided to you by your OCTEC teacher. It may lead you to a page that looks like this. The red highlighted area on the below image will show you where to click to log in.





#### Step 2. Logging in to Moodle

You will be taken to a page to put in your login credentials. You username is your firstname.lastname and your password is what was provided to you by OCTEC. If you are signing in for the first time, you will be prompted to change your password.

If you forget your password, contact your trainer to ask for it to be reset.
